Attached is the Feb letter from our missionary, J F Brandon. The picture is of one of the Sunday Schools on the mission field. Brother Brandon says that there are many community preaching points as well attended as this one. This picture is a glimpse of what your money and ours is doing in Brazil.

Little things in the hands of God accomplish much. Read his letter to you while you are alone in your quiet time. Read the scripture passages in connection with it and then pray for the missionary and his work. You will profit by reading it again.

We are trying to get at least one hundred people who are not already giving, to have a part in this work. We now have a list of seventeen some of which are giving regularly each month. Remember that all that is given goes to support missionary J F Brandon and his family and the work on the mission field. The cost of mimeographing, postage etc is paid by some who love and support the work and is over and above what they give for the missionary. Brother Brandon left Brazil with his family last May for a year in the States. He has been laboring in Brazil since 1923 (18 years). He expects to return as soon as the arrangements can be made. He is an independent Baptist Missionary and is supported entirely by those who give as the lord leads. He is out on faith and faith alone.
