### BAPTISMS FOR SIX CONSECUTIVE WEEKS

Dear Brethren:

Cruzeiro do Sul, June 21 1944

There is a boat in port but I have not had time to go to the Post Office. I arrived yesterday afternoon from a journey and am behind in my work from every point of view. I should have been in a journey for the upper Jurua ere this but it has been absolutely impossible. Last Sunday was the first in six weeks that we did not have a baptism, but I have been away and the brethren let up on the work when I am not here, or it seems that they do. I was in Morpirango for fifteen days and there was a great meeting of the Lord with his people.

#### REVIVAL AT MORAPIRANGO

I was called to Morapirango because of a contention among them. There seemed to be a good deal of difference so much so that some unbelievers were taking part and it had the appearance of something ugly. After preaching to them and praying with them for a week, there was such a change that pen cannot record. I invited them for a business meeting in which the power of the Lord was manifest in presiding, the result was, they wept over their foolishness and happily forgave one another with embrace. This happened on Saturday afternoon and then on Sunday Morning the young man who wanted to kill one of the believers and his father, came to Sunday School. He had been a regular attendant for three months.

### A WOULD BE KILL R IS SAVED

As the Scriptures were opened to them, the Lord opened his heart that he might receive the word unto salvation and when no one expected he came forward confessing the Lord Jesus as Saviour and Lord. I felt that it was the best ending to a sad beginning that I ever experienced. The next afternoon in a small settlement about a mile and a half away a man who had rejected the Lord for a number of years, his wife is a believer and a sister to the pastor, was taken suddenly ill and he thought his time to travel had come and he cried with the sincerety of his heart "Lord Jesus give me one more opportunity" and the Lord heard his cry. They sent at once for me and in the company of a brother I went to visit him in his grief. When we went in his anxious look betrayed his weary sinful heart. I sat down beside him and opened the Bible and calmly read and explained the way of life to him again and the effect of the Word upon him was more than I can put on paper. After a time he grasp me by the hand and with tears in his eyes declared that what he felt in his heart was more than he could put in words, and such a restful peaceful feeling he found it difficult to explain.

### AN IDOL WORSHIPPING WOMAN IS SAVED

The next night the Lord saved a woman who a few years ago was the most devout idolater I ever saw. When she came to give her profession of faith, she was in tears as she said I loved those things, referring to her images, as much as a person could, for I trusted in them for salvation, but now I have cast them away and come to walk in the light of the Lord Jesus. Maybe you think I wasn't happy, but I was and all of the brethren seemed to be too. I am counting on these three conversions to mean much in the future. While this was going on there the pastor records three others here in Cruzeiro do Sul that he says are equally important.

#### BITTER PERSECUTION RECENTLY

I know that the Lord is with us for good, recently persecution has been bitter. I am not excited when I tell you that the lives of the ones who work here are in danger, so I request that cur lives may be precious to the Lord for service and that if it should be death, then it be for His glory. The Rolan church here is entertaining a Catholic Congress for the next ten days and a great figure among them arrived on this boat. He is outspoken against America in the war and very bitter in his remarks against the Eaptists. Such men do much to stir up strife among high thinking people and many are being influenced by him.

#### THE LORD IS SAVING SOULS

The Lord is saving souls and that is why I am here. I hope to teach these who are being saved the doctrines of truth. A letter from Brother Cicero says they are waiting for me up there. The work seems to be going fine, the river is low but as soon as I can get off I will go. I request your prayers for open doors for the gospel in all of these places. The other day there was such a revolt against us in the village of Mumaita that the Brother who was there came to Cruzeiro do Sul to save himself. A Turk and Cerman priest raised the people up in revolt. The officers are not interested in protecting us. I don't know what the result will be, we are but few and very weak and if the Lord doesn't look after us it will be too bad. For this reason I request you your prayers for open doors and effective with courage and boldness to onter in ADMONISHING US

God bless you all is our continued prayer. May His great and amazing grace be yours without measure. Remember me to all the brethren and the ones who are interested to inquire. I hope that you will find everything better in Detroit and that your ministry with the Harmony Church will be a decided victory for you from the very beginning. Only be bold and very courageous, don't fear what man can do or say, but go to the Lord to find out what He wants you to do and how it should be done. You can depend on Him. I have heard many ministers of the Lord remark "well it was customary and for that reason we did it." I tell you brother I feel that the less we observe the sustom and the closer we walk in the light of the word of the Lord, the happier we will be and the Churches will be better served.

## A VISIT TO LARGOINHO

I returned yesterday from Largoinho, a family of believers live at the mouth of the river. I passed a few days with them confirming their faith, teaching and exhorting them to a better and more spiritual life. The river now is so low that the distance is too far for the neighbors to attend the worship. In the winter they go by canoe to the door but now it is more than a mile to the first house. There was a neighborhood of people living half way between there and Cruzeiro do Sul. I stopped and passed the night with them. I preached Saturday night and Sunday morning. (Cont on page four)
