J F BRANDON RETURNS FROM MISSIONARY JOURNEY HAD GREAT LIBERTY TO PREACH THE GOSPEL

Dear Brethren:

Cruzeiro do Sul, Sept 26 1944

We left Amonho on the 13th and arrived in Ouro Preito on the 14th. The believers there wanted us to remain another day with them and so we did. They sent far and near to invite the people who would come to hear the gospel and the house was well filled and we enjoyed a wonderful service, blessings indeed from the Lord. The Lord must have something in mind that I am not able to see. I never had such liberty to preach the gospel, and recently I have observed that people are really convicted of sin. Early on the morning of the 16th we left for Campo Santano where we arrived in the late afternoon.

75 PRESENT AND 55 REPEATED VERSES

There they were anxiously waiting for us. There were some people who lived eight hours journey away and they wanted to be called to hear the gospel when we came, so these were called and attended the baptizing in the afternoon of the 20th and preaching at night. You should have been with us on that occasion. I feel that I never saw such an open expression of joy. We have taught them to memorize verses of Scripture and the last night there were 75 present and 55 repeated verses. The Lord saved a young man who gave his profession of faith, and ever so many songs were sung, in fact it was more than 11 oclock when the services ended.

29 BAPTIZED BELIEVERS IN THIS SECTION

I sometimes wonder if you believe what I write. Conditions may be changed tomorrow, nevertheless they are thus today. At present we have 29 baptized believers in this section visited, with four others who have not been baptized as yet, 33 in all. Just the age of our Lord at the cross. Must these too be sacrificed? Or will someone from there come out to take up the work and develop these and others who are to follow? We left Camo Santano on the morning of the 21st and arrived at 10 P M on the 24th, completing a 400 mile journey by canoe. Praise the Lord for His wonderful grace.

HUNDREDS OF BAPTIST MISSIONARIES NEEDED

The Roman church is doing all possible to hinder the work of the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and at present all missionaries are being hindered from coming to this country. Brother it will be well to call our churches together in prayer that this effort will be defeated by the God of heaven, and that literally hundreds of Baptist missionaries will be sent out with the bread of life to feed the perishing millions. I was away 58 days and when I returned there was but one letter for me and that was from John. So I wonder what has happened now to hinder the mail. Yesterday was a great day with us here in Cruzeiro do Sul. All through the day the Lord endeared Himself to us and the fellowship was so sweet. Our Sunday School services were good and the afternoon services well attended, but the night service was one of the "Old time religion sort". Praise God for such hours as these which enlarge our visions of eternity, magnify the grace of God and draw the humble hearted so close to the Lord and to one another that the veil seems entirely No one saved but all so happy. (Over) removed.

PERSECUTED UNTIL IT HURTS

We are being persecuted until it hurts. May God give us grace to endure. The cruelty of the Roman church is so great that if it were broadcasted there in a Christian land among educated, refined people they would not believe half of what was told them is true. John 8:44 is the best verse in the Bible that describes her as she really is. In John's letter written on the 29th of February 1944 and received today, it looked very much like he was looking this way for the future, yet he didn't say so in words. The work has never been easy but the Lord has always been faithful and that is what made it seem so nice all the time. Remember me to all who love the coming of the Lord Jesus from heaven, and may His amazing grace be multiplied unto you all, Amen Read it again--Deut 31:6-8. Sincerely, J. F. Brandon

MISSIONARY AND MRS A A BORKER

As most of you know Brother and Sister Boeker have answered the call to go to Brazil and work with Brother Brandon. As this is being written the Boekers are taking shots for typhus, yellow fever, typhoid fever and tetanus and being vaccinated for small pox. Because of the war none of the steamship lines carry passengers to Belem Brazil which is at the mouth of the Amazon river. Brother Booker has made reservations with Pan American Airways to go by plane sometime in April. by plane from Miami Fla to Belem for them is \$848.13. In addition to this there are the train fares from New Jersy to Miami and in addition to this there are the boat fares for the forty day journey of 3500 miles up rivers to Cruzeiro do Sul. In addition to this, they must have room and board on the journey while waiting for boats to sail etc. They also must have a supply of clothes to take with them. Then there is the matter of other equipment such as a typewriter, radio, camera, amplifier and loud speaker equipment and a first aid and medical kit. The folding organ has been bought. The Boekers were put on salary beginning January first 1945. He is now trying to get passports, and permits to buy and take the amplyfier and equipment into Brazil. The money for all these needed things must be over and above that required to support Brother Brandon and the native missionaries on the field and Mrs Brandon and the children here in the States and the salaries for the Boekers. We have asked for \$2500.00 over and above the amount needed for the regular expenses. To date we have received only \$300.00 \$2200.00 is still needed. Will you pray about this? of this amount.

FAITH

This is a faith mission and we believe that God will supply the needs. We believe that there are enough people who want their mission money to be used for real New Testament mission work to support hundreds of Baptist Missionaries in destitute places. Those who support this mission work receive first hand information of what is going on where their money is being used to preach the gospel. None of the officers receive and pay for their services. There is no rent paid for office space. It is a Baptist Faith Mission and we invite you help by send-your offerings to the Treasurer.
