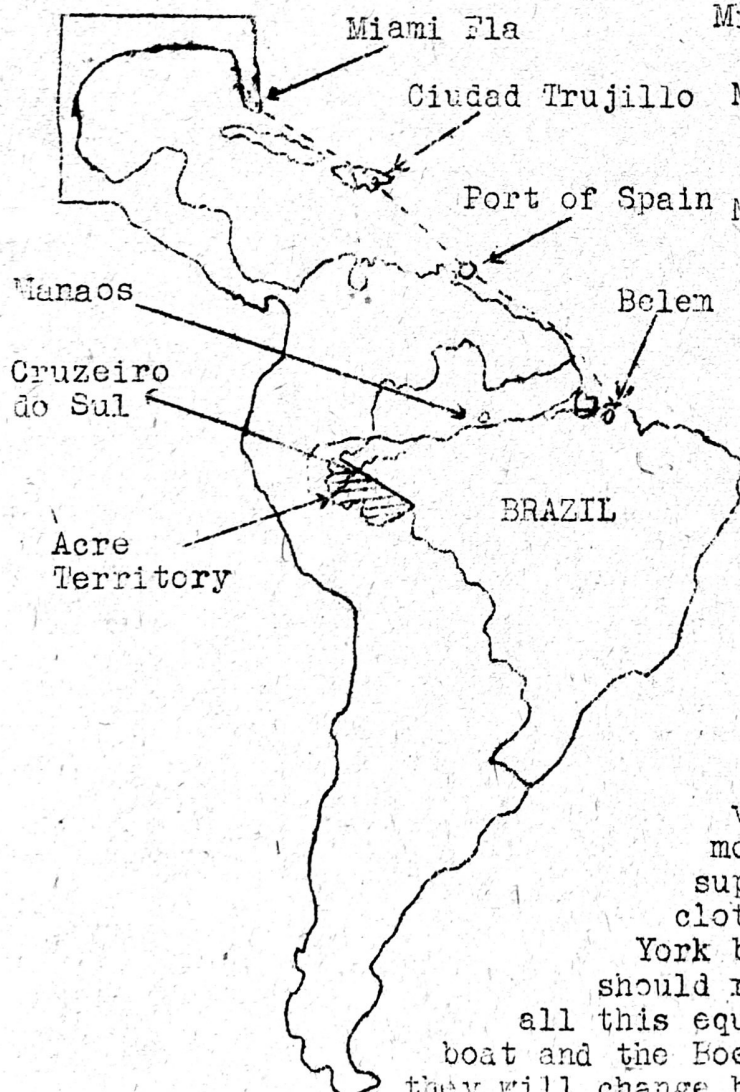

MISSIONARY A A BOEKER AND FAMILY REACH BELEM, BRAZIL

Elder Aaron A Boeker and wife and two children left Miami Fla on Wed May 30 by plane for Brazil. At the end of the first day they were in the Dominican Republic and spent the night in Ciudad Trujillo. At the end of the second day they were on Trinidad Island and spent the night in Port Of Spain. At the end of the third day they were in Belem, Brazil at the mouth of the Amazon river. Here they must wait the equipment that went by boat from New York then they will start the long hot, hard journey up river to Cruzeiro do Sul. Study the map below and trace their journey thus far and note the location of the mission field in the Acre Territory etc.

May 30--from Miami Fla to Ciudad Trujillo, Dominican Republic. By plane.

May 31--From Ciudad Trujillo to Port Of Spain, Trinidad Island. By plane.

June 1--From Port of Spain to Belem, Brazil at the mouth of the Amazon river By Plane.

The equipment which included a folding organ, amplifier and loud speakers, motor and battery charger, radio for both short and long wave reception which can also be used to play records for broadcast over the loud speaker equipment, first aid kit and medical supplies, vitamin tablets, typewriter, movie camera and picture finishing supplies, household goods and clothes. All these things left New York by boat on Saturday May 26 and should reach Belem about June 16. Then

all this equipment will be loaded on a river boat and the Boekers will go to Manaus. Here they will change boats and go up the Amazon river to the mouth of the Jurua river and then up this river for 2000 miles to Cruzeiro do Sul where they will join Missionary J F Brandon and work for five years and then come home on furlough.

A TIME FOR THANKSGIVING

It was last August 1944 when Brother Aaron A Bosker first heard of Brother J F Brandon's mission work in the Acre territory of Brazil. Since then much work has been done. All the equipment has been bought that is listed on page one and also a still camera that has not been received as yet. This will be shipped to Brazil as soon as it is received. Then the getting of the passport and the Visas and the equipment packed and stored and then moved to the docks at New York and opened and inspected and repacked and then loaded on the boat. The boat lines would not carry passengers due to the war so passage had to be arranged by airplane. The reservation on the plane had to be cancelled on one occasion because the passport and Visas were not in hand. Then finally the passport came and then the Visas and the equipment was shipped and four days later the Missionaries left by plane. No human being could have planned it so. The Directors of Baptist Faith Missions met in February for a day of prayer at New Hope Baptist Church in Dearborn Michigan. We read letters from Brother Brandon and his prayer requests and then we prayed about these requests and the equipment, the passport and Visas and that passage would be granted and all at the right time. The Lord heard and answered. Now we are careful to give the Lord all the honor, all the glory and all the praise. Surely this is a time for all of us to humble ourselves and give thanks to Almighty God. Blessed be His holy Name.
