Dear Brethren, April 16, 1973 God has blessed us with a good month of health, work and progress in the work. There is far more to do than we can accomplish but God has blessed us with health and strength. Everyone is looking forward to the arrival of John Mark and his wife Judy who are to arrive three days

from today. Mrs. Hatcher is rather nervous about the arrival because, you see, she has never had the experience of having a daughter-in-law in her house before and she doesn't want to fail to be a good mother-in-law, I suppose. As for me I'm not nit bervous about

their hetting gere. How- John Hotcher ever, Kathy and David have many, many things for their new sister-in-law and if she lives through all they can plan, she will not have any trouble with the rest.

In my last letter I mentioned that our enrollment was up about 18% in our schools. Since that writing there have been more enrollments and we now have an over-all increase of about 30% over last year. Believe me when I say that there have been and are many who work against our school. God has given us the best group of children this year that we have had and we have a larger number of Baptist children this year than other years. Most of all there seems to be a real interest on the part of many lost students to really know the truth about salvation. Our daily convocations are attended by all the students and the attention is better than most preaching services in our churches. Many of the Catholic students are coming to our church services. But the greatest need that we have is laborers.



The church and I raised another \$360.00 on top of the \$250.00 of B.F.M. money already being used to give our present church building owner. He loans it out on interest and by doing this we can save our monthly rent toward building the building. We may have to move the Church in two months, but where? I've no idea. 




Richard Turner this month. We are having these services outside at the home of a member of our church on Saturday nights.
