

The task of finding teachers is difficult since we do not have the Christian background here and most are Catholics. Therefore, we must locate teachers who are qualified and Baptists. All teachers, staff members and employees must be Baptists and active in their churches with lives that reflect Christ in and out of the class-

room. The school ministry has a strong daily emphasis present-ing the gospel. Here the school operates three shifts: Paul Hatcher 7-11 a.m. Kindergarten through high school 1- 5 p.m. Kindergarten through high school 7-11 p.m. High school only 7-11 p.m. Seminary


