Greetings,

As you are aware, one of our pressing needs is to get Brothers Crain and Stanton to Peru as soon as possible. Why is this so urgent? There are 1000's in Peru still who have never heard the saving Gospel of Jesus Christ without which man can not be saved.

Many have responded to this need and we do thank God for you. Now if just 400 more would respond with only \$5.00 each on a monthly basis, then you will be able to get Brother Stanton there. If offerings hold as they are now, Brother Crain will be able to go to the field the first part of January. Wouldn't it be great to get them both there at the same time? We can, if you will permit God to use you, will you????

Word from Korea is that the Mission works are in the best overall shape they have been in since 1979. Thank God for those faithful pastors. Yes, just part of your mission work.

Several pastors have expressed that they would like me to come to their churches and hopefully help get their people more stirred for missions. The Holy Spirit will have to do the stirring but I'm willing to be His instrument, just contact me. December and onward is basically open now. Let me hear from you.

Questions and Answers

What authority do the Directors have to do the work they do?

Each director is a member of a Baptist church and does his work of helping the missionaries under the authority of a church. If we would do something unscriptural our churches could discipline us. Each of our missionaries were sent out by a Baptist church to work with the Directors of Baptist Faith Missions. Offerings are sent in to the Directors from churches who indicate how they want them used, either for designated projects or general support of the missionaries. The Directors use the funds as the churches authorize them to be used. Our work of helping the missionaries is largely to see that the offerings get to them from the churches and the reports of their work get back to the churches.

The church at Corinth had an offering to send to Jerusalem to help the work there. They could send their offering by "whomsoever" they approved or authorized, 1 Cor. 16:3. That means they could send it by a member of their church or another church if they desired.

In 2 Cor. 8:18-19 we are told of a brother who was "chosen of the churches to travel with us with their grace." This one man was authorized by several churches to carry their offering or "grace" to its intended destination. He could only be the member of one church and yet he was authorized by several churches to do a job for them. This is what the Directors of Baptist Faith Missions do.

The Directors believe strongly that the Lord has given the authority to carry out the great commission to His churches. This is why we are very careful to work under church authority. Matt. 28:18-20; 1 Tim. 3:15; Eph. 3:21.

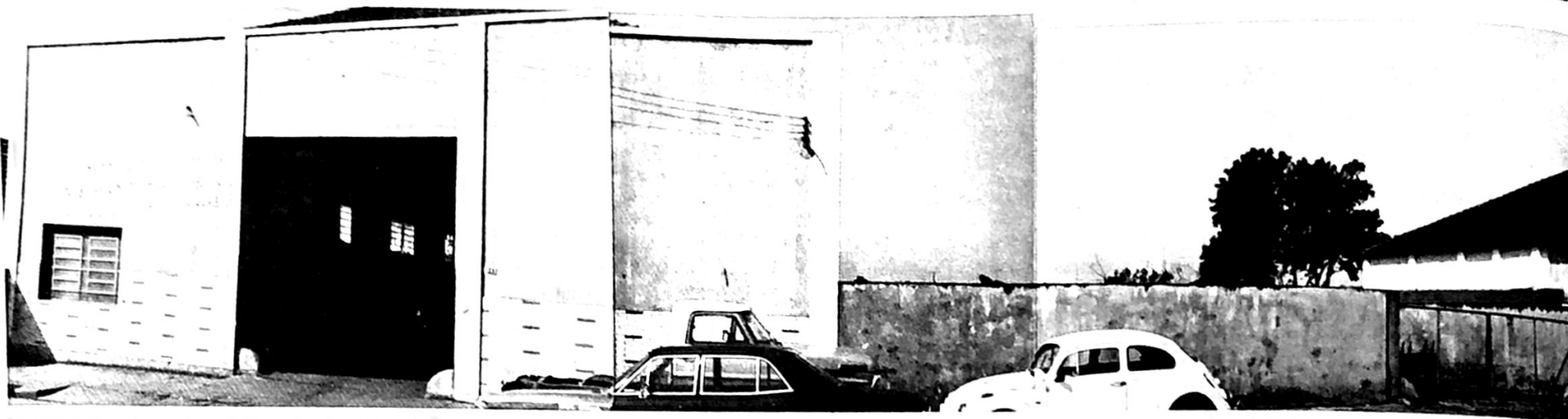

We send greetings from Brazil. We are being blessed in our work here. We are praying about opening up a new work this month. We will know about the building on the 11th of this month. If all goes well, we already have a preacher for the work. We are really praying that this will go well. We have three preachers in our church here in town. I want to see them used in the Lord's work. One young man has a desire to go to Bible College. He may leave us to do this in January. One brother has consented to take over the new work if it is the Lord's will that we open it. The other Brother has the desire to go to our work in Anajatuba which has been without a regular pastor for over two years. This will take away about half of our membership here at the church, but we are happy to get the gospel message further out into the "highways and hedges." Please pray for us at this time. I feel that we are at a crucial time in the work here. I am praying earnestly about a helper here at New Hope Church. I am serving as

pastor here and trying to support and preach some at the other works. When I leave the services here I have nobody capable to carry on the work. I have a young preacher in mind and he is praying about it. Pray about this with us also.

We want to express our thanks to the Harmony Baptist Church in Camden, Tennessee who designated the money for this. It has been a tough 3 months on the flesh as we have tried to get things organized here at the house and at the same time battle minor sicknesses. But the Lord has been with us. We do desire your prayers about my wife's health. She is bothered a lot with allergies. We may have to go to Fortaleza for her to consult a doctor. Remember our daughter Melody as she tries to adapt to Brazilian school. But most of all pray that the Lord will anoint us with the Precious Spirit and give us power in our lives to be effective witnesses for Christ.

New Work Begins In State Of Parana . . . Three Brazilian Young People Coming To Work . . . Good Building Available . . . Importance Of A Building To A New Work

GOOD NEWS . . . WORK HAS BEEN INITIATED IN THE STATE OF PARANA, THE SIXTH STATE IN BRAZIL FOR THE WORK OF BAPTIST FAITH MISSIONS. On October 4th, our daily radio program was started in the city of Cornelio Procopio in the State of Parana. This State is the 4th largest in Brazil with a population of 10 million. Our radio program will have the possibility of reaching 150 thousand listeners. This daily broadcast is paid for by Alta and me out of our salary - not out of our tithe. The cost of the program is \$180 a month. Now, let me tell you about the plans for this new work and then pray and ask the Lord what He would have you do to help.

In January there is a team of three who are coming from Manaus (Seminary) to work in this new city. These young people are leaving their jobs and making a complete surrender to God's will in this new place. This city is 3,000 miles from Manaus. The mission does not pay them a salary. They will work to provide for their living until the work grows enough to support them.

We do need a building for the work. There is a beautiful building available. It is in the center of the city. The building is 65' x 98' and has a side lot of equal size. There are times when the dollar exchange is favorable and right now is such a time. This large

building, capable of seating over 600 persons and large lot can be purchased for approximately \$25,000. It can only be purchased for cash, or at best, one half down and one half in 60 days.

Many do not understand why buildings are so important in a new work. Let me explain:

1. The purchase of an adequate building saves at least one year of a missionary's time in building.
2. It provides immediate accommodations for services.
3. It eliminates the cost of high rent. Usually rented buildings have to be remodeled with a loss of material when building is vacated.
4. In face of all the different religions and sects, a permanent building offers a stable aspect to the work.
5. After the initial purchase of the building, much of the remodeling and necessary changes can be done by the people as they are needed. This they are reluctant to do in rented property.
6. The purchase of an adequate building, where possible, is much less expensive than building a new building due to inflationary costs of material and labor.

Remember, buildings are very important to established churches, yours for example. They are just as vital to the success of the Lord's work, when they are possible, in pioneer mission work.

\$25,000 would give us a large adequate building in the new work in the State of Parana. Your help is needed now. Call or write us and tell us what you will do.

This month has not been so good as other months here in our work. Our highest Sunday School was only 51 and we only had a couple of Sunday Night services with more than 60 present. We had several visitors also present with us from time to time.

These last two weeks I've been a bit discouraged with the work here as the people are not showing the interest that I would like them to show. It seems that they are so busy making a living or going to school that they have so little time for the things of the Lord. Some of the members are not even attending the services like they should. However, there is a reason to be encouraged in that our attendance for this year has been on the whole much better than last year. We have not seen as

many saved as we would like but we can't say that God hasn't blessed us and given us the opportunity to preach the Gospel to many lost people this year.

From time to time, I mention in my letters to the Mission Sheets the hope of being able to turn our work over to a Brazilian pastor. We are still praying and work toward this goal. Again I would ask that you remember to pray that this might be a reality soon.

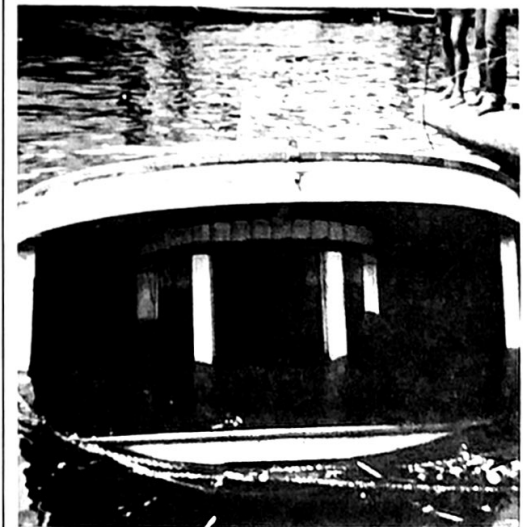
