Terrorists Destroy and Hurt in Many Places . . . Report on Churches and Missions . . . Needs Presented . . .

Dear Brethren,

In our last mission letter I was on my way to Huanoico to check on the work and buy the lumber and metal roofing for the new building in Paucar.

While I was there I got the work started to finish the Bible Institute rooms. Before, when I went there, there was no building material. We are thankful to get this work started again.

I am thankful for the Grace Baptist Church, Bradenton, Florida, who gave to finish this work.

Last Wednesday night as I started to preach we had a blackout that destroyed the lights in five Departments (States). We were without electricity for three days and at this moment the electricity has not been restored in Ventanilla. The terrorist bombed several electric towers at the same time. Everything was planned to happen at 8:00 p.m. At that time they also attacked the Nissan auto plant and burned it to the ground.

The terrorist have taken over three towns in the Department of San Martin. The government has declared a state of emergency in the States of San Martin, Amazonas, Huanoico, Huancavelica, Lima and Callao. I have works in San Martin, Huanoico and Ventanilla is part of Callao.

The government has sent in armed forces to try to restore order in the jungle where the terrorist have taken over the jungle towns. Brethren, please pray for the following places: **PROGRESO** - There, we have work started with a house and mission building, but, we cannot go there because of the terrorist. We cannot sell the property because there is no one there to buy. We have one family that is trying to keep the services going. **AUCAYACU** - Is another center of terrorist and drugs. The work grows a little and then the terrorist hit the town again and the people scatter again. Pray for the faithful pastor who keeps preaching and staying with the stuff. **HUANOICO** - The town itself seems to be calm, but, Tingo

Maria is part of the State of Huanoico and is another center of terrorist and drugs. The church in Tingo Maria is still growing. They have started a new mission. They have full time services in the home church and two missions. The church in Huanoico also has two missions. Zion Baptist Church has three missions. Pray for these Brethren as they reach out in their own areas.

I leave in a few hours to drive to Huanoico to help organize the work at CUNHUAYUN into a Baptist Church. They have over forty baptized members and they have their own building (adobe), but paid for.

While I am in Huanoico I hope to get the construction started in CHAVINILLO. The mission there is under the authority of Zion Missionary Baptist Church of Taylor, MI, which is my home church. They have given the money to build the walls and the building. Thank you Brethren at Zion. **AYAPITEG** - Because of the faithful Brethren who have been going each week (by motorcycle) in all kinds of weather, many times riding four hours in the rain and mud, the work has begun to show new interest. Some have returned to the work and some new ones are now coming. Two Brethren leave every Saturday evening to preach Saturday night and Sunday in Ayapiteg and Chavinillo and arrive back in Huanoico at about 2 a.m. **VENTANILLA** - We are still waiting for the title to the land. They now say we may have the title by the 3rd of December. I baptized four two weeks ago and we hope to baptize again in two more weeks.

I have been suffering with what the doctor calls Cunt! It feels like I am walking on needles.

A NEW PROJECT - YANTEG - The Zion Baptist Church has started a new work and they have about thirty baptized members. They have land and are building their own building (adobe). They need lumber for trusses, metal roof, windows and doors. \$800.00 will do it. Who will help them? Today was Thanksgiving. We had Ada Mayfield, Sheridan and Anita Stanton with their children Joshua and Leah. It was good to be together with them.

Another School Year Comes To An End . . . 37 Professions of Faith . . . Pray As Brazil Prepares a New Constitution . . . Report on Judson . . .

Dear Bros. & Sisters in Christ,

The present school year for the Centro Educacional Batista das Americas (the Elementary and Junior High School) is now coming to a close and we already have 350 children besides those presently attending on a waiting list for the next school year. The next school year does not begin until the end of February 1988. All of our teachers are Baptist, and all but two are members of Tabernacle Baptist Church. This year a good number of the students received Christ as Saviour.

Opportunities abound, the fields are indeed "white unto harvest." In addition to your faithful financial support, we need your prayers that we would effectively use the open doors.

At a recent Evangelistic Meeting primarily for young adults we witnessed 37 professions of faith. David and Penne are now preparing a group of young people who will be doing mission work during the month of January. They will be working with Baptist Faith Mission missionaries in southern Brazil. They will be canvassing for evangelistic meetings, helping in the meetings and with follow-up of those who make professions of faith.

120 students just concluded the last series of Seminary courses for 1987. The next series of courses begins in January. We are now working intensively with two students who will be going to work in Porto Velho. Both are graduates of the two year program. These final preparations (morning, afternoon and evening) include everything from bench making to counselling as well as plans for the first year on the field. The Seminary extension at Chapada is going quite well with 35 students.

During the past year the camp has been used more effectively than ever before. We averaged one camp retreat every six weeks. Some of these were primarily for evangelism and the rest were for follow-up of new believers or edification of longer term believers.

Pray for the government of Brazil. The Legislature is now framing a new constitution. At present it appears that the new constitution will be very socialistic. Pray that the Lord will keep the doors open for the spread of the Gospel of Jesus Christ in Brazil.

Our family is doing well. Judson continues restricted to crutches. He will be x-rayed again in December. We thank each of you who have prayed on his behalf.

May the Lord richly bless each of you.

Visa Problem Continues . . . Makes Benches and Busy Land . . . An Ordination . . . 10 Profess Faith . . .

Dear Brethren,

How would you like to live in a place where it has not rained for six months? Our water is being rationed and we may not even have any if it does not start to rain soon.

Our visas have not come from Brasilia yet. Our lawyer has been to Brasilia and talked to the Justice Department and they told him they would send the process to Brasilia-Sao Luis for us to reopen our request for our visas. All we can do is wait and pray. June and I could not leave the country if we wanted to. Of course, we could turn in all our documents and lose our chances to get our visas, etc. Brasilia says there are ten thousand cases like ours here in Brazil.

I have made 16 benches for our congregation in Cantanhede. I have made at least two special trips buying land and getting it registered in the name of New Hope Baptist Church. Saturday, October 24th, we had services in the house we bought with 120 people present. November 7th, we had ser-

vices with 50 people present and at the close of the service a woman made a profession of faith in the Lord.

Anajatuba - Monday, November 9th, five preachers from Sao Luis went to Anajatuba to ordain Bro. Trindade to the Gospel Ministry. After giving a good account of his profession of faith, his call to preach and his views and response to the questions asked him concerning the doctrines about the church, salvation, and other Bible related doctrines, the Council recommended that the Brother be ordained. Bro. Silvester preached the charge to the pastor; Bro. Satu preached the charge to the church. Bro. Jovo Batista presented the Bible and Bro. Padua presented the book by Bro. T. P. Simons on Bible Doctrine. They had had a 70 year old man and a 25 year old man saved Sunday and after the service a 14 year old boy made a profession of faith.

At New Hope Baptist Church we have had seven professions of faith and two rededications. We have many members who are sick. I preached a 70 year old woman's funeral, who had been saved in July '87.
