# IAL FOUNDERS' DAY EI



Brother H. H. Overbey was one of the three men who organized Baptist Faith Missions as we know it today. He served as Executive Secretary for forty years. One could not be around him without knowing of his love for missions, and because of this he was affectionately known as Mr. Missions.



Brother Z. E. Clark served as the first Treasurer of Baptist Faith Missions, an office he faithfully filled for 25 years. He, too, loved missions and did all he could to help the work of Baptist Faith Missions.



Joseph F. Brandon was the first missionary of Baptist Faith Missions. He organized many churches in Brazil, including the first ones in the western part of the country.

# A Word About This Special Issue . . .

APTIST Faith Missions traces its roots to Alfred Eric Nelson who went to Brazil in 1891 as the first Baptist Missionary in all of the great Amazon Valley. He went without any base of support whatsoever, working at whatever he could to support himself and later a wife and family. In the early 1920's, H. B. Taylor, Pastor of the First Baptist Church, Murray, Kentucky, hearing of Nelson, went to Brazil and spent four months with him, visiting up and down the great Amazon River and some of its tributaries, seeing the great need in the Amazon Valley. When Brother Taylor returned home he led the church he pastored to organize Amazon Valley Baptist Faith Missions. The purpose of the mission was to raise support for Nelson and to help anyone else who felt called of God to go into the Amazon Valley to preach the gospel and organize churches. Over the next few years there were several missionary families who were sent out by A.V.B.F.M., but there were only two who remained any length of time. After about 20 years A.V.B.F.M. ceased to be.

Baptist Faith Missions, as we know it today, started in the early 1940's when H. H. Overbey and Z. E. Clark met with missionary Joseph Brandon, who had gone to Brazil with A.V.B.F.M. in 1923, about his continuing to serve in Brazil. Overbey and Clark agreed with Missionary Brandon that if he would go back to Brazil they would do what they could to raise support for him. Brother Brandon was to write a mission letter each month and Brother Overbey would print it on a mimeograph machine and mail it to interested churches and individuals in an effort to raise support for Brother Brandon. Brother Z. E. Clark was to serve as Treasurer of any funds that came in. The first "Mission Sheet" was mailed to about 30 churches and individuals. In it, Brother Overbey told of the work and made an appeal for support. The second Mission Sheet contained a letter from Brother Brandon on the subject "The Importance of Small Things." It reported that \$14.00 had been sent in as the first month's offering.

From this small beginning, Baptist Faith Missions has continued to send out missionaries as the Lord supplies the needs. With this special Founders'Day Issue of The Mission

Sheets, we honor some of those who have served and some who are still serving on the mission field. Some of the pictures in this issue were in early issues of The Mission Sheets. Some have never been printed before. Read each word, study each picture and give thanks for those who have "Labored in the heat of the day."

Each year we designate June as FOUNDERS' MONTH and ask churches and individuals to send a special offering to help with our financial needs. We hope that this special

edition will prompt you to send a special offering this year to help our missionaries.

We have a taped message by Brother H. H. Overbey that he delivered at the Twelve-Ryan Baptist Church, Warren, Michigan, on November 21, 1984, telling of the history of Baptist Faith Missions. # First Missionary to Brazil . . .

A. E. Nelson, the first missionary to Brazil, is pictured here with his wife, Ida. Nelson would sometimes be gone on mission trips that would last for months. By the time of his death in 1939, he had traveled an estimated 1,965,000 miles (3/5 of the country of Brazil) preaching the gospel. His travels also carried him into Peru, Columbia, and Bolivia. He organized thirty Baptist Churches and had many preaching points. He is sometimes referred to as "The Apostle of the Amazon."



# Missionary to Peru in 1935 . . .

Brother Richard Patrick Hallum, His wife, Mary Francis, and daughter, Marguerite, went to Peru in 1935 as missionaries with A.V.B.F.M. It took them 39 days to make the trip from their home in Louisiana to Iquitos, Peru, which was to serve as their home base for the next twenty years. It was in Iquitos on February 24, 1937, that he organized the First Baptist Church of Iquitos which is the oldest Baptist Church in Peru. The church was organized in the Hallum home in a room that was used as a meeting place until a church building could be built. There were eleven charter members of this church; the Hallums and eight Peruvians. When funds from A.V.B.F.M. were used up, the Hallums came to work with Baptist Faith Missions. Brother H. H. Overbey referred to Brother Hallum as a work horse saying, "He doesn't prance around like a show horse, but you can see where he has been." 


