Dear Pastors and Saints,

"Truly God is good . . ." (Ps. 73:1a). This past summer was one of great challenges and many victories. Fair Havens Camp, (our summer program for low-income families whose children would be on the streets), was a tremendous success; thanks to many of you for your financial support. Of the five weeks there were 227 boys and girls. As I mentioned before the main purpose of this program is to preach the Gospel and teach the Word of God. There were 103 children that trusted in the Lord Jesus Christ. Each was given a Bible, and all the other children were given a New Testament.

Our Vacation Bible School took place on August 11-15. There were a group of folks from the mainland (U.S.) that came and helped us. There was a record attendance of 171 children and adults. This was the first time we had VBS for the whole family. It was great. From this effort, we now have 9 adults and 15 children who, not only believed in Christ, but also are attending services regularly.

On August 26th, I went with our son, Andrew, to get him registered at Pensacola Christian College. God is working out his fees in amazing ways. Please pray for him.

Our Bible College began on September 2 with two ministerial students and 15 part-time students from St. Thomas and St. John (V.I.). We also have begun a correspondence school as part of our Theological education. So far we have 5 students in Jamaica. Those students would like to attend our school but due to family responsibilities cannot come. If you have some materials that can be used for this purpose, please help us. There is a great need. Later on I shall visit these areas.

Our Christian Academy opened its doors with 45 students (this is all our facilities can accommodate), K5-Grade 3. It is truly a wonderful opportunity to have these boys and girls each day not only for the academics but to teach them the Word of God. This is a mission as we reach out to the poor families, and most of them do not go to any church, and are not born again (the parent/guardian). We have had 3 mothers (single parent home) to become interested in the Bible as a result of their children doing Bible lessons homework. We NEED teachers for 1998!

Our Church is experiencing the blessings of the Lord in an extraordinary way. Two weeks ago, a young man 37 years rededicated his life to the Lord (he is from the mainland U.S.), after attending our church for some months. He was added to the church and is now being trained to work with the youth. This he believes is God's calling in his life. We are praising the Lord because we have been praying for a youth leader for years. Being black himself, he can bridge the gap of the youth and proclaim the Gospel of Christ to them. The attendance at all the services are very good; Sunday morning about 95; evening, 58; Bible Study, 62. We have a membership of 36. I teach the Adult Sunday School Class (II Peter); preach a.m. and p.m.; Bible Study Wednesday (Gospel of Luke); teach in the Bible College three days a week (O.T. Survey, Hermeneutics, and Homiletics). Also we have visitation, shut-in services, Home-Bible Study (by others); Children's ministries. God has blessed us with many dedicated men and women, and together, we trust the Lord to use us for His glory. "Truly God is good . . ."

Thanks for your financial support, without which these efforts would not all be possible. We always remember you in our prayers, and extend an invitation to send your pastor to visit the work and get a first hand experience, and to be a blessing to us. Again, thanks and God bless you.

Dear Friends,

What is tithing? In a mathematical sense, it is one tenth (Gen. 28:11). In a Scriptural sense, it is a law (Deut. 14:22). Morally, it is a debt (Mal. 3:8). As economics, it is an investment (Matt. 6:20 and Luke 6:38). In the spiritual meaning, it is a blessing (Mal. 3:10).

Jesus said a lot about money. Matthew 6:24-34 warns that we should not let money be the number one priority in our lives. Matthew 25:14-30 is the parable that Jesus tells to illustrate that we should not waste money, but to use it wisely. Mark 10:17-31 tells us to share with the poor. Like adults, teens often equate money with success. Did you know that there are summer camps to teach kids how to manage mutual funds? Money can be dangerous when it threatens your relationship with God or makes you greedy. Christians are called to use their money wisely and to share it. Take an inventory, evaluate your budget, consider your money God's money.

What kind of a giver are you? If each church that supports the missionaries through Baptist Faith Mission would increase their monthly giving in 1998 to the General Fund by \$50.00 there would be sufficient to send and maintain a new missionary to the foreign field and also would provide a small increase to the missionaries now serving! The most unique thing about Baptist Faith Mission is that our missionaries go to the field of service without doing deputation work. We go by faith in God that He will provide through you our supporting churches. What kind of a giver are you?

A little boy walking down the street with his mother one day, he told her that when he grew up and earned a lot of money he was going to help a missionary. He said, "I think I'll support a whole mission station and a hospital too." "Are you sure you'll feel that way when you get the money?" asked the mother. "Oh, I know I will!" he answered confidently. "If I had it right now, I'd give it; but you know I don't have any." Just then he spotted a coin on the sidewalk. Before his mom could get out the word "missionary" he had darted into a nearby store. Moments later he emerged with a pocketful of his favorite candy. So many are like this little boy.

However, Dr. Oswald Smith tells of delivering a message in which he stressed the need of consistently returning to the Lord a portion of our material possessions. In the course of the sermon, he quoted Luke 6:38 and then said, "You just can't beat God when it comes to giving!" Near the back of the audience was a shabbily dressed man who had lost his job and was having family trouble. Bowing in prayer, he not only rededicated his life, but also told the Lord that he would be faithful in the use of his money when he found new employment. To his amazement, within a few hours he was offered a job. Beginning with his first check, he fulfilled his promise by giving a generous portion to the church. Later he secured a better position and continued to increase his offerings. He then came to Dr. Smith and told him of the wonderful changes that had taken place in his work and in his home life. He concluded by saying, "I've found that what you said about being generous with the Lord is right. He has been true to His word." Please pray about an increase to the General Fund of BFM.

Some say, "I've given him the shirt off my back and now look what he has done to me," or "I've given him the best years of my life and look at what I get in return." If we bestow a gift or a favor and expect a return for it, it is no gift but a trade. Do we really understand what it means to give?

I'll leave you on a higher note. When the family returned home after the Sunday morning service, the father criticized the sermon, the daughter thought the choir sang off-key, and the mother found fault with the organist's playing. The whole discussion came to an abrupt end, however, when the small boy of the family said, "But it was still a pretty good show for a nickel, don't you think, Dad?"

Anita and I love you in the Lord. If we've not already been in your church then we hope to be with you soon! The works in Peru are going great! Until next month.

The city of Manaus is literally in chaos. There is an electrical shortage due to corruption and mismanagement. Lights are out all over the city at least 6 hours daily, for the last six months. Last week an article came out in Brazil's largest

news magazine about the situation. It said in part: "The lack of electrical lights has transformed Manaus into a hell." In Manaus, the most popular bumper sticker is: "I love Manaus and I hate Eletronorte" (the electric company). At the courthouse the lawyers and judges

cannot use their robes because the air conditioners can't work. Judge Aristoteles Lima commented: "I have the sensation I am in hell paying for my sins." Added on to this, water is off most of the day and the traffic is one big jam-up because the mayor is constructing 3 overpasses at the same time. Interestingly, the light and water bills go up each month. That is why a brother prayed last Sunday during the worship service, "Lord have mercy on Manaus and forgive the sins of the electric company."

Despite all this, the work goes on and His presence continues to be felt among us in a marvelous way. On Sunday, the 17th of August, at 5 o'clock p.m., 17 (seventeen) of us met at the St. John the Baptist Cemetery, at the grave of my brother, Joel Harold Bratcher, for a memorial service. It was on that day, 26 years ago, that he fell overboard and drowned in the Amazon River. It was a time of recollections, fears, and thanksgiving. Saudades, continue.

At the beginning of October, two special evangelistic services were held. On Saturday and Sunday nights, the 11th and 12th, our young people (around 80 of them) put on a musical presentation, based on the story of Noah and his Ark. At the end I preached and the Lord blessed. Saturday night, all the Baptist Faith Mission Churches were invited and 866 people were counted. Then on Sunday, for our members and guests, over 500 people were present. There were some 15 decisions. Saturday was also Missions night and despite the recession, over \$4,000 was received for the works in the interior on the rivers of the Amazonas.

In the midst of victories, defeat! Wednesday night the church had to exclude 4; a couple and a brother and sister, for fighting among themselves and taking the case to court. May the Lord have mercy on them and their families (which are all members).

I conclude sharing with you two urgent needs. Since the beginning of summer, we have been building by faith a new building for our mission point at the Village of Amatori. Their old building is about ready to fall down. I have helped Brother João all I can, and we have spent over \$2,500. They have been able to put up the brick walls, and the road is finished. Yesterday, it broke my heart to tell Brother João that construction would have to stop until funds came in. We need about \$2,500 to \$3,000 to completely finish the building that sits on the banks of the mighty Amazon River, as a tribute to its Creator.

Also, we have a chance to buy for around \$2,500 a lot next door to our building at the Bencaõ (Vessel of Blessing) Mission Point, at the suburb Cidade de Deus (God's city). A charismatic group (the universal church) wants to buy it to build a church building, but the owners have given us first preference. They need \$1,100 as a down payment and will accept the rest by monthly payments.

Pray for all of this and for us. The family sends their love to each of you. We love and appreciate each church and individual that has stood with us during these 20 years. Continue to do so, as we need you now more than ever for the days are evil and the Lord is coming soon. I can't wait, can you?

Greetings from Brazil. We trust all of you are being blessed in the midst of your trials. Somewhere along the line I woke up to the fact that Romans 8:28 includes me too. But as this Thanksgiving approaches I and my family have so much to be thankful for. We thank the Lord for a measure of health in spite of the aches and pains; we thank Him even more for our soul's salvation and for that of our children; we thank Him for giving us over 20 years of ministry in Brazil; we also must thank Him for all of you that make it possible by your liberality and concern for souls.

Here in our part of Brazil we are presently enjoying showers of blessings both literally and spiritually. South of us it is flooding and North of us there is drought. We are in perhaps the hottest part of South America to start with and with this El Niño effect we have been really suffering. It has even hurt our church attendance. Now the Lord has sent some much needed rain. Our river has been at record low levels and now is being replenished. Over a million of us here depend on it for water. Also, the rain has given some relief from the intense heat. As for the spiritual blessings, we have had one more saved in the Altos do Coxipo work. At the Varzea Grande Faith Baptist work they are baptizing about every month. The Boa Esperanca Church has been in a building program totally financed by them and also they have had some unexpected problems in the lives of a few members. The Lord has helped the pastor to grow and he seems to be handling it with wisdom and courage. Yes, Satan does attack the Lord's churches through the weakness of the flesh. None of us are immune. May the Lord give us all faith and grace for this evil day in which we live. The Primavera Baptist Mission will be organized into a New Testament Baptist Church on December 27th at which time we will ordain two faithful Brethren in the Gospel Ministry. They are being blessed and are working hard almost all on their own to build a bigger building around the smaller one in time for this service. The Chacara dos Pinheiros work is very stable. It has solidified and grown some as the pastor and family have grown. I am praying about a new worker for this work where I am now. 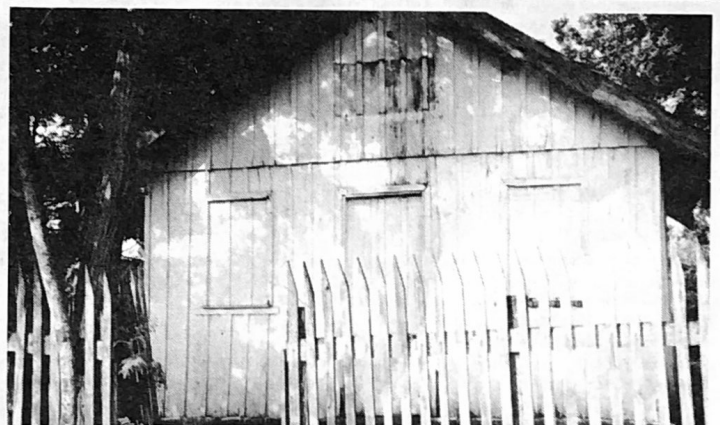

The crowds were really great and the results, too. There were several saved and many of our members surrendered their lives to a number of ministries. Saturday and Sunday nights we had overflow crowds. On Saturday night I took a peek outside and found out that there were over 200 people that couldn't get in and were just milling around in the street. Just a note as to how much things are changing here: there were over 20 motorcycles, 45 cars, 2 busses and 2 trucks lined along the streets on the corner where our building sits. All of these vehicles were there because of our services. When I was a kid there were only a couple of Jeeps in this town!

One of the highlights of the meeting happened during the closing service. Each missionary and his family were called to the platform for the church to give each family a special, surprise present. In the weeks before the conference I had visited the missionaries to see their most pressing personal needs. They didn't know I was spying on them! Edson (Rodrigues Alves) got new sound equipment. Mario (Porto Walter) got a new refrigerator. José Maia (Thaumaturgo) got a new gas stove. Rivaldo (Serra do Moa) got roofing and hardware for the parsonage. They were all shocked speechless. They are supported full time by First Baptist Church. They also get gifts of food each month and other household goods. This was a little more than the usual though. It was fun to see their reactions.

I enjoy being a missionary. Our church is enjoying being missionary, in every sense of the word. Are you enjoying?

God at Work in Rancho Alegre

The weekly Monday night services in Rancho Alegre continue with God's blessings. Not only Alta and I see the difference God is making in their lives, but they are seeing the differences in their own lives. What Grace! They are looking for a house for us to rent or buy. In many ways this mission is different from any in the past. We have never started a work before with the majority being alcoholics, but never have we seen such interest among grown men. None were saved. Now there are six who are. Never have we started a mission where the grown people love to sing like they do. Future Buildings

Presently, we are negotiating for a pre-fabricated building in Leopoldis. It will cost us about \$5,000 for the basic building and covering. If this proves satisfactory we will build two more; one for Nova Fatima and the other for Urai. Folks, we could use your help if God so leads.
