What the apostle Paul says of one of his fellow-workers, "...who has worked hard in the Lord," can certainly describe our church family during the past summer months.

A great deal of work had to go into the summer camp facilities for the opening of camp June 28, and continued for six weeks. The last two weeks were children that desperately needed love and instruction. We were asked if we could help them, and after much prayer, and financial assistance from some stateside brethren, we were able to work with the dren (64 boys and girls). 41 received the Lord Jesus as their Savior. Praise the Lord. We still continue to keep in touch with them, as some are from St. Croix and St. Thomas. Of the four weeks there were 240 children, and 98 received the Lord as their personal Savior. How we praise the Lord for His blessings.

On July 27, we had our Bible School graduation. Two young men received their diplomas: one. Dean McIntyre (Jamaica) continued his education; the other, Roger Rampersadsingh (Trinidad) went back to his native country, and is working with Brother Sentoma in his school as a teacher, and seeking to plant churches in other parts of the country. Our Bible School presently has three full time students, (not foreign), and twelve part time students (four from other islands).


Our Christian School with K-4 through Grade 3 with an enrollment of 50 students is a mission work and not just an academic institution. We teach these boys and girls the Word of God with intent that they may come to know the Lord Jesus as their personal Savior, and continue to teach them the truths of the Scriptures. 99% of these children are from homes that are low income, parents that go to no church, and do not come to ours either, except when we have parents-school meetings. At that time, I preach a simple gospel message, and praise be to our Lord as a result we are seeing interest in 15 parents. We are now making

jungle town of Pucallpa last week. We had three saved, several rededications and one coming for baptism. This church was organized back in May of this year. I was able to take care of the legal papers for the Mission properties while I was there. The Jordan Baptist Church of Pucallpa has started a new mission work down river at a village called Tushmo. The Lord has really been blessing this new work. Please pray for them as they need help to get a suitable building constructed. Also the Faith Baptist church of Pucallpa has a new work seven kilometers down the highway. It is called the "Nueva Bolognesi" Baptist Mission. Brother Pedro Aquino is the worker there. It is a very promising young work. They also need help with purchasing some property and then building.

Here in Huanuco the construction for the Bible Institute is coming along well. However, we are short about four thousand dollars in order to finish it. The walls are up and the doors and windows are in place, but we need to get it under roof before the rainy season starts next month. Folks, we sure could use some help toward this. I have classes scheduled for November! Pray about it.

The Faith Baptist Mission in Huaral reports good services. I'll be going there the end of October to be with them and encourage them. The Ebenezer Baptist Mission in the south of Lima is having some difficulties right now. The contract on the place we rent for them ran out this month. We've tried to raise enough funds in order to buy some property for this work. However, not enough has come in so we must relocate the work to another rental location. The Lord knows what He's doing. They have good services but have been somewhat discouraged lately. Please pray for Brother Carlos Estabridis and his family as they labor in the Lord's work in this area. I'll be going to visit them also the end of October.

Anita and I thank all of you for your prayers, letters, and constant giving to our ministry here in Peru. Please continue to pray and also please remember the Stanton Building Fund. We also thank the Lord for each of you that give faithfully month after month to all the mission works through Baptist Faith Missions. The Lord uses you to make the work go and grow. May God continue to bless each of you. Until next month.
