Dear friends,

February 7, 2006

January was a great month. We had our daughter Mary Katherine here with us for 30 days, but to be truthful she did not only come to visit us, she came to continue a courtship with a young man here in our church. There are times that parents take a back seat when there is love involved. While on this visit Mary became engaged to Walimir and we are rejoicing with her. He is a young preacher boy that has just completed four years of seminary in Sao Paulo this past year. He is working here with us in the main church. His desire is to become a pastor. As a father you want the very best for your children and especially a daughter—well, God has sent His best; she fell in love with a preacher! While she was here this is what I saw: they wanted to be together and when they were together they saw only each other, and together they didn't need anyone else. How awesome is the power of love. Saying this, we see how much our Lord and Savior loves us. Enough to die for us then we see that saving grace has no boundaries of countries. Then we see because of that love we must reach the world for Christ and even more as we see the day approaching. So rejoice with us as it looks like we will be getting an extra worker here in Caraguatatuba, Brasil. Pray for Mary and Walimir as they plan their future together. As a father I could not be more proud of our daughter and her future husband. I know that they will be serving the Lord together here in Brazil. Barb and I have dedicated our lives to serving Christ here in Brazil and it is good to have another member of our family serving alongside us.

The mission building is 95% completed as I write this letter. How AWESOME is the Lord we serve!!! Myself and one brick layer and six young men have done the construction. Here I see even more the importance of the vocational school. We are training young men to build physically and also spiritually. It has been a very rewarding two months of labor and I see a multitude of benefits being harvested. Pray with us as we will be needing four dorm rooms constructed on the grounds of the school with two baths. To have young students

We will take a few days to visit with our family and then return to Brazil and the wonderful work God has given us here.

Mission In Dangerous Area ... Help Missionary Get Settled ... Special Request For Anita And Josh ...

Dear Friends,

February 1, 2006

Anita and I hope this letter finds all of you walking with the Lord and aware of His blessings in your lives. Our Lord continues to bless here in Peru in many ways.

So many of the young couples in our churches here in Huanuco have given birth to their first child in the past two months. This includes Pastor Russell Juica and his wife, Susanna, of the Iglesia Bautista de Gracia. All of the babies have been girls so far! So many of these couples I have married over the past several years and now it brings us great joy to see them grow into young families dedicated to serving the Lord.

We are in the midst of putting in a tile floor in our large institute room where we teach Bible classes to the pastors and preachers from around Peru. The tile looks great but it seems to be taking an eternity getting it done. I hope to have it ready by the time of our next class in March.

A house has been located in the town of Acomayo, where we can help get a new work started. It is a dangerous area at this time due to the rise of terrorism but we have several families in the area and the possibility of a young preacher and his wife to work there. I would be able to go in during the days but not after dark. We are still waiting on the Lord to 'bring it all together,' for this new work. Your prayers please.

The middle of the month found Anita and I in Lima to help another young missionary couple get settled in. Jayson and Andrea Minix arrived in Peru to begin their language studies. They are also out of the Jordan Baptist Church of Sanford, Florida, where my dear friend, George Sledd is pastor. Jayson is Pastor Sledd's son-in-law. Anita and I have worked under the authority of Jordan Baptist for twenty-three years as missionaries and five years before that as the church's pastor. We located a nice apartment for the Minixs just a few blocks away from their language school. We stayed a week with them to help them learn their way around and to get them started on the resident cards. They appear to have adjusted very well and are deeply engulfed in the study of the Spanish language. Pray for them.

We would really appreciate your prayers for Anita's hands. She has suffered with severe pain in both of her wrists and forearms since November of last year. It has gotten progressively worse and has begun to interfere with her everyday life and work. Some days she cannot even turn the key to get in the front door. The Doctor here says it is tendonitis and has put her on anti-inflammatories and therapy treatments, so far we have not seen much improvement. Please put Anita on your prayer list. It is not a major illness or life threatening, but for a woman that is used to writing and preparing Sunday School materials for all of the works here in Peru, this is a difficult adjustment. Thanks for your prayers. Anita and I also ask you to remember our son Lieutenant Joshua Stanton, US Air Force, in your prayers. Josh was recently sent to Columbia on his latest tour of duty. Pray not only for him and his safety, but also for his wife, Cheri, and our granddaughter, Caroline. Cheri and Caroline, had to stay in Tucson, Arizona. There are so many soldiers separated from their families at this time. We should all be praying for their safety and for special grace for their families.

Cultural Adjustment ... Good Prison Report ...

Dear praying friends, February 4, 2006
Another month has come and passed so quickly and there are many important items to update each of you on. My wife and I praise the Lord for good health and for the strength He has given us as we are in the process of cross-cultural adjustment. The Lord has been so faithful to help us during this time of adjustment and we know He will continue to help us in the various challenges in our lives.

I am pleased to report the progress on the prison ministry. I am now working with an excellent class of students within our Bible school. They are so devoted to the Word of God and have truly challenged me as I have taught them the fundamental doctrines of the Bible. The desire of these prisoners to learn and study the Word of God in depth amazes me, and I thank the Lord for each one of them. We are giving them an excellent foundation in the school, as we are teaching on the doctrines of the Trinity, the Bible, the Church, Salvation, Prophecy, etc. There are also in depth exams to measure their progress and understanding. My goal is to expand the Bible school even further in the future as the Lord opens the doors, so please be in prayer for this aspect of the ministry. I am seeking to train faithful men who will also train others (2 Tim. 2:2)

I also praise the Lord for the other evangelism and discipleship class that is continuing. Last month, we had a new group of prisoners, around 70 in number, and I was able to clearly present the gospel to this group. Many had never heard of the true way to heaven, through Christ Jesus our Lord, and around 30 prayed to receive Christ as their personal Saviour. Evangelism is commanded in the Bible, and we thank God that He has allowed us to be involved in this critical work for the kingdom of God (Proverbs 11:30). We pray for these new converts, and also for their continued spiritual growth. How Satan would love to steal their joy in Christ and discourage them, so please pray that they would continue to grow and become mature Christians in the future.

This next week, we have visitors from Emmanuel Baptist Church in Ohio. Please pray for this group of nine, that we would have a great time together and also minister as a team to reach the people of Kitale. They will be here for 13 days, so please pray that God would not only use them greatly to minister to the African people, but also challenge us as missionaries to grow even further in our plans and developments for the future. Visitors are always an encouragement, and I will be sure to give you a current update on their time here next month.

In regards to our financial needs, please pray that the Lord would continue to burden others to help us meet our financial goals. We praise the Lord for additional support received this past month.

If the Lord would burden you to become a part of our financial or prayer team, please contact us at the information above. We are trusting God to provide, in His time and plan for us. (Jeremiah 29: 1-11) We know He has a plan for us, and we continue to trust Him. God bless you and we will be sure to keep you updated.

Visit Elementary School ... Teens Leading Others To Christ ... Many Trials and Temptations ...

Dear Special Friends, February 4, 2006

We hope that this finds each of you well, and enjoying the blessings of our Lord. We have had a busy first month of the year, and will continue to be busy for some time.

We finished our classes in Sunday School on Baptist catechism last week. Our members have learned much from the catechism classes. Pam taught the youth, and I taught the adults, so we feel that we have laid a good foundation to build on in the future. Very few churches here teach what God's Word says, as emotionalism, loud music, women preachers and/or prophets, etc. are the rule here. We want our people to be grounded in their faith, so they will know what God's Word says, and not follow the crusades that come so often, and the teachings that are so prevalent here, but have no basis in the Word of God.

A couple of weeks ago, we had some great teaching in our Bible Institute as we studied Community Health Evangelism. We had four teachers who came, and they stayed with us to teach the classes. This concept is so needed here, as the people are so poor, and they depend on us, instead of God, to supply their needs. Community Health Evangelism is an approach that integrates the spiritual with the physical to look at the needs of the whole person. It is a very good way to do church planting, as the people in the church are trained in lessons that relate to the physical problems of the people, but each lesson has a spiritual teaching as well. The Gospel is integrated throughout, and the people are taught how that they can look at the problems in the community, such as lack of clean water, sanitation, etc. Then, they are taught how that they can do problem solving, and use the resources that they have in the community to fix their own problems. It is community development, and not relief. Also, the members of the community are visited in their individual homes to talk about their problems there, and using the physical lessons of how to address the problem, they are also taught a spiritual lesson, too. So, communities improve themselves, and learn income generating activities that they can do to improve their lives. At the same time, they are taught God's Word as it relates to their particular problems. In the course of these teachings, people receive Christ, are disciplined, and churches started. We are excited about this concept and are anxious to begin using it. There were 18 who faithfully came from Imani Baptist to be trained in these lessons.

In relationship to this, we visited an elementary school in the area of Imani Baptist to talk with the principal about starting a Bible club at the end of the school day on Tuesday each week. Dennis, our oldest orphan who is 19, was trained in children's ministry for four months last year, and he has already started a Bible club in the neighborhood of our church on Saturday afternoons. He meets in the home of one of our members to teach the kids in the neighborhood about Jesus Christ: he had 32 children present this past Saturday. So, Dennis and Jared, one of our Bible Institute students who will be taking the position of pastor in our new church, started working this week after school teaching the Bible Club. Dennis taught over 200 students in grades 4-6 in his Bible Club, while Jared had over 130 students in grades 7-8 who stayed after school for his club. All of us are so pleased with this opportunity to teach the Bible in the public schools here and present the Good News about Jesus Christ. Dennis has been asked by the principal to return on Friday mornings to teach the Bible in their chapel time to the students. God is good.

It was such a blessing to Pam and me this past Sunday as we went with our team to do soul winning evangelism in the neighborhood around Imani Baptist. We observed two of our teens on our team lead two people to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ as their personal Savior. Esther is 13 years old, and Perice is 18. Both of them have a real desire to live for our Lord, and to tell others about Jesus Christ. We are reaping the fruits of our teachings. Esther is also teaching in our Junior church program, while Perice teaches Sunday School to the young children.

We have 9 visitors coming to see us in two days from Emmanuel Baptist Church around Dayton, Ohio. This is Pastor Darrell Messer's church, and has been a faithful supporting church of ours for many years. We are looking forward to their visit, and Pam is looking forward to being able to once again go into the bush to do medical clinics while they are here. The helicopter has been repaired, and the pilot has told Pam that she can start to fly again.

As with any ministry, there are many trials and temptations. Satan is not happy with the progress of spiritual fruit that is coming forth as a result of God's Word being preached and taught. There are several things that we are praying about at this time, and asking God to intervene. Currently, they are unspoken prayer requests, so we would covet your prayers for us, and these issues.

Thank you so much for your prayers on our behalf. Without your interest, love, and encouragement, it would be hard for us to be out here away from our parents, daughter, son-in-law and granddaughter, brothers and sisters, friends, and others that we love. We do count it a privilege to be here in this area of God's harvest, but we definitely need your prayers in order to continue on.

probably assure you your pastor won't ask you to do this for him, though. Someone else in the church will need to take the initiative to ask your church body to give your pastor this gift. That someone may be YOU! Will YOU step up and do this for him and for the benefit of our Conference? He (and other attendees) will come back to you more charged up with the passion of following the Lord Jesus Christ and serving with Him to reach the lost peoples of the world.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, January 31, 2006
May this find you enjoying God's presence in your life. We thank God regularly for your faithful unwavering support. Please rejoice as you read the highlights of what God has been doing here as the New Year begins.

Last week we began a new Bible study in the Gospel of Luke in Portuguese. Rosana is Brazilian. They moved into our neighborhood last year. Rosana's husband, Claudio, works for a Brazilian company that does business in Europe. She speaks only Portuguese. He speaks English as well. Rosana is thrilled to be reading God's Word for herself. She hopes that her husband will join us in studying the Bible. We have been able to spend a fair amount of time with this family and had opportunities to share what we believe. Would you take time now to pray for them?

Another promising encounter took place about two weeks ago. As folks were leaving our house after Sunday morning service, Alain, our next door neighbor called to me over the hedge and said, "We would like to have you over for dinner this week." Alain had entrusted us with a key to their house on two different occasions during the past year so that we

could keep an eye on things and water their plants. The request to watch their house came as a surprise to us as our only contact previously with them had been a few words exchanged over the fence. We had not seen much of them lately either, so we gratefully accepted the invitation to dine with them on the Friday following the invitation. We had been in their home for about five minutes when Alain said, "So, you're a pastor, what kind are you?" I responded, "Baptist." He then enquired about the differences between the Catholic Church and Baptist Church. This gave me an opportunity to explain about salvation through Christ alone, by grace, apart from the church. Later on, during dinner he volunteered, "I would like to believe, it would be reassuring, but I don't think that humans are any different from the other animals, only smarter." This, of course, led to lengthy discussion. We talked about God's revelation in the Bible and the evidence for its truthfulness. Before long they had taken out a two volume, highly decorated, illustrated Bible and the discussion continued. They volunteered to come to Sunday services sometime. Alain and Anne are typical French; they live a comfortable lifestyle but are very unhappy.

On the same weekend, Nathalie told me at the end of service, "It's over." She was referring to her decision to stop dating an unsaved man that she had been seeing for 8 months. This is an answer to prayer. She has also been spending time with Claire, a lady who used to live across the street from us. Nathalie has been encouraging Claire to come to church with her. We are encouraged to see Nathalie growing spiritually.

Attendance has been up recently in our Sunday services and our various Bible studies our going well. Judy is teaching English again in the public school. She does this for free in two third grade classes. It is an open door for her to build relationships with people in our community.

Thanks again for your prayer and support. Remember us and the cause of the Gospel in France as you pray. And, be watching for people around you who need to hear the Good News.

Greetings from Sao Paulo, Brazil!

February 7, 2006

This past month of January was extremely busy. As many of you may already know we decided to return to Brazil permanently as Missionary Support Workers through Baptist Faith Missions. We are grateful to know that the Lord's will is continually being fulfilled in our lives.

Our purpose in Brazil is to recruit, train, place, and network effective church leadership to reach Brazil, and from Brazil send missionaries to the other 8 Portuguese speaking countries. We desire to see a church-planting church in all 27 federal units (26 states and the capitol) of Brazil. I arrived in Sao Paulo (the largest city in Brazil with 21 million people) a week ago. We are currently at Raquel's parents' home. While here in Sao Paulo we've accomplished much research, driven/scouted around the city and have met with several people. We've gained valuable insight for starting a church here in this great city. Just today I drove around town with a real estate agent for three hours and took several pictures of strategic locations.

This last Sunday February 11th, I was invited to preach at the Sunday morning service at Igreja Batista de Ferreira and in the evening at Primeira Igreja Batista de Jardim Sao Marcos.

We leave for Manaus this Saturday, February 11th. Already, a couple there awaits our arrival for their wedding. I am excited. This will be the first wedding ceremony I've performed.

We shipped a 20 foot container with our belongings from Virginia Beach, Virginia, to arrive in Manaus at the beginning of March. Pray for the container to clear quickly through customs and for all our belongings to arrive safely.

Raquel's health is doing well, despite a dry cough at night. Her pregnancy is progressing successfully. Our second child is due July 22, 2006. Sarah Isabel is now ten months old and she walks and jumps around all over the place. She understands English and Portuguese extremely well and has a rapidly growing vocabulary in both languages.

Call as often as you'd like. We have an unlimited international VoiceOver IP plan so it won't cost us any more for you to call us regularly. We'd love to hear from you too!
